



## BIG DANCE

### Tomorrow's Men 2012

Building on the success of Jeanefer's previous projects for the Big Dance (including Bolero Re-mixed, which brought together over 70 community dancers with the New London Orchestra in a performance as part of the Greenwich and Docklands International Festival), Tomorrow's Men has been invited to deliver a large-scale production working across 8 East London borough to deliver dance activity to a range of groups and participants.

The project, funded by the [East London Business Alliance's Transformers Grant Programme](#) through the Olympic Lottery Distributor and [Big Dance 2012](#), brings together a team of male dance artists who will work with 100 young men from across east London over 10 weeks to build their confidence and develop their dance and performance skills. The project culminates in a large-scale performance as part of this year's [Greenwich and Docklands International Festival](#), where the group will perform alongside professional dancers in Canary Wharf as part of **Dancing City on Saturday 30 June '12**. As part of the project, Tomorrow's Men is working with a team of role models of who will visit the participants during rehearsals, talk to the young people about their experiences, answer questions about their careers and inspire them to make their ambitions a reality.

East London Dance has been awarded a Transformers grant, funded by The National Lottery, through the Olympic Lottery Distributor, and managed by ELBA to deliver this project. Tomorrow's Men has been funded by Legacy Trust UK, creating a lasting impact from the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games by funding ideas and local talent to inspire creativity across the UK.
